

Firearm Policies for ATSAA Hotels

Please note: If you are attending the Sporting Clays Event, scroll down for hotel information and individual policies.

OMNI FIREARM POLICY

- All guests with firearms must have them locked in cases at all times.
- All rooms will be automatically opted out of housekeeping service.
- Guest is required to disclose firearm upon check-in
- Guests are required to have their cell phone numbers on file.
- No luggage store allowed firearms.

HILTON GASLAMP QUARTER FIREARM POLICY

- The hotel does not allow firearms on the property.

MARRIOTT MARQUIS FIREARM POLICY

Weapons should be in cases while being transported to and from guest rooms. If left unattended and not in a case inside a guest room, Housekeeping will not service the room.

- Every reasonable effort should be made to secure a weapon in a safe deposit box upon a guest's request.
- Hotel should inform the guest that hotel associates will not handle the weapon and that the guest must place the weapon (if a firearm, unloaded) in the safe deposit box.
- If the weapon does not fit into a safe deposit box, the hotel should inform the guest that storage is not available and that the guest must make other storage arrangements.

HARD ROCK HOTEL FIREARM POLICY

- Any firearms Coming to Hard Rock Property must go through our Security Team.
- The firearm will be stored on property in a secure location under 24 hours video surveillance.
- No firearm will be allowed to be taken to a Hotel Room.
- Due to Hard Rock Hotel not having a clearing barrel, the firearms must be cleared with no ammo before Hard Rock Security takes possession of it.
- It's required that the firearm is dropped off in a "Pelican" type hardcase for safety
- The hardcase must have locks and the keys are kept with the owner of the firearm.
- The security director, Chris Redmond will meet with the guest on 6th avenue for the transfer of the firearm.
- The director of security will have contact with the guest before arrival to coordinate for pick up and drop off. Chris.redmond@hardrockhotelsd.com
- Hard Rock Hotel does not permit any ammunition to be stored on property, including guest rooms.

- If any guest knowingly or unknowingly takes a firearm or ammunition to a hotel room, they will be evicted from the property and will not be compensated for their early departure.

EMBASSY SUITES FIREARM POLICY

- Firearms are to be in a protective case.
- Guests will need to put the Do Not Disturb sign on their door, as housekeeping will not be able to go into the room. Guests must call down to have fresh towels delivered and their trash removed, but housekeeping will not be able to go into rooms.
- Firearms are not brought down into the breakfast or evening reception. (meaning, the guest will need to eat or drink and then get their gun before they head out) We just don't want the other guests to be scared.

HILTON SAN DIEGO BAYFRONT FIREARM POLICY

- The hotel does not allow firearms on property.
